1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 28.02.2023 passed in CWP-2727-2023.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has produced copy of pension re-fixation order showing that the petitioner is being paid increased pension without effecting any recovery from the amount already paid in excess before passing of the stay order. Even the document (Annexure P-2) relied upon by the counsel for the petitioner, does not reflect any recovery from the pension, as such, though the pension is being paid at the reduced rate, as stated by the counsel for the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to interfere in the matter.
