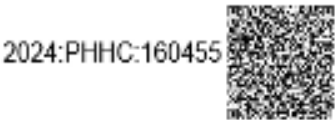

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondent No.4- Assistant Collector, 2nd Grade, Uchana, District Jind to decide their application dated 23.08.2024 (Annexure P-11) under Section 122 of Punjab Revenue Act, 1984 (for short '1984 Act') in a time bound manner.

2. The petitioners claim that they have filed application dated 23.08.2024 (Annexure P-11) under Section 122 of 1984 Act for possession of land, *Rasta & Khal* as per final mode of partition, however, respondent is sitting over the matter. The mode of partition has already been finalized, thus, respondent authority is bound to decide their application.
