The instant petition is disposed of with the liberty to the Gram Panchayat concerned, to consider the passing of an appropriate resolution thereby alienating the suit land in favour of the petitioners, and, if the said resolution is favourable to the present petitioners, the same be forwarded to the competent proving authority for thus a decision being made thereon.

2. However, it is clarified that the above order may not treated as a mandamus for the relevant purpose rather being made, upon the competent authority concerned.
