The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in case bearing FIR No. 797 dated 03.12.2023 under Section 20 of NDPS Act (Section 29 of NDPS Act added later on), registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh, District Panipat.

[2] Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Ranbir, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of order dated 22.12.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

[3] In this view of the matter, interim order dated 22.12.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
