Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondent to grant recognition to the petitioner-Body as per law and to decide the application (Annexure P-3) dated 26.07.2024 for the said cause, which is pending for the last 4 months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite having applied for seeking recognition by way of an application dated 26.07.2024 (Annexure P-3), nothing fruitful has been done so far and the application submitted by the petition is still pending for a period of more than four months.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sudhir Nar, Sr. Panel Counsel enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent; and prays for some time to complete instructions and file reply.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, contends that he would be satisfied at this stage, in case the Competent Authority of the respondent is directed to consider and decide the application dated 26.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondent does not raise any serious objection to the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing the respondent (through its Competent Authority) to consider and decide the application dated 26.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of four months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that upon considering the said application, if the petitioner-Body is found entitled and eligible for the relief sought herein, the same be granted in his favour without any further delay.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
