SANJIV BERRY, J. (ORAL)

By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioners seek quashing of FIR and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 08.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) executed between the parties. Details of the FIR (Annexure P-1) are as follows:

2. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide compromise deed dated 08.12.2023 (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal, vide report dated 31.08.2024, has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between



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the parties is genuine and without any pressure. The petitioners have also deposited cost of Rs.15,000/- in compliance of order dated 13.08.2024.

3. Respondents No. 2 and 3 are represented by their counsel and do not oppose the compromise.

4. In view of the report of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in “Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and “Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping the criminal proceedings pending, since the respondents No.2 and 3 have themselves compromised the dispute with the petitioners/ accused persons.

5. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 656 dated 19.11.2023 under Sections 148, 149, 307, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 32/33, District Karnal and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise qua the present petitioners.
