1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 31.05.2019 passed in CRM-M-25910-2019.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of the respondent, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 31.05.2019 passed in CRM-M-25910-2019 has been complied with. The representation of the petitioner has been decided and the allegations levelled therein were found to be false.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
