1. By way of present petition the petitioner seeks interim bail for a period of one month pending trial in case bearing FIR No.62 dated 02.03.2015 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 302, 34, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Sohna, District Gurugram on the pretext that his daughter is getting married.

2. Petitioner is facing trial in the aforesaid FIR. Arrest warrants of the petitioner were issued on 27.09.2016. However, he evaded the same. He was declared proclaimed offender and P.O challan was submitted on 30.07.2018 before the concerned court. In view of the fact that petitioner was declared PO in the aforesaid FIR with respect to offence punishable under Section 174A IPC also came into being. Petitioner was arrested on 26.09.2023 and since then he is behind bars.

3. Status Report filed by way of affidavit of Naveen Sindhu, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Sohna, Gurugram is taken on record. Copy has been supplied. As per the Status Report, the fact of there being marriage of daughter of the petitioner scheduled on 22.01.2024 is admitted. However, bail plea is being opposed by referring to the prior conduct of the petitioner.

4. Keeping in view the conduct of the petitioner and the fact that he being father of the daughter is required to perform certain rituals and ceremonies, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail for a period of 10 days. He shall be released on 15.01.2024 subject to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate and shall surrender back on 25.01.2024. In addition to the conditions that may be imposed by the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, the petitioner shall remain bound by the following conditions as well:-

- (i) The petitioner shall not mis-use the liberty granted.
- (ii) The petitioner shall not commit any offence while on bail.
- (iii) The petitioner shall deposit his passport, if any at the time of grant of bail.
- (iv) The petitioner shall give his cell-phone number to the police authorities and shall not change his cell-phone number.

5. Petition stands disposed off.
