This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of order dated 31.08.2023 passed in CWP-19119-2023.

Compliance report on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 filed in the Registry is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the respondents have submitted that the order dated 31.08.2023 passed in CWP-19119-2023 has been complied with, speaking order dated 05.04.2024 has been passed and necessary benefits have also been released to the petitioner. Necessary documents to this effect have also been attached with the compliance report.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
