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**SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)**

1. Through instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks the issuance of a writ, order or direction, especially in the nature of mandamus thus, directing respondents No.1 to ensure the assumption of possession over the disputed lands, rather by the Gram Panchayat concerned.
2. Learned Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions imparted to him, submits that the verdict of eviction, which has been asked to be complied with, by the writ petitioner, rather has acquired conclusive and binding effect. Earlier the writ petitioner had instituted a Civil Writ Petition No.15579 of 2023, and, on the said writ petition, the hereinafter extracted directions were made by this Court, on 24.07.2023

“1. The learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present writ petition, but with liberty to file an execution petition before the learned executing court concerned.  
2. Leave granted.  
3. Consequently, the extant writ petition is disposed of, but with the above assigned liberty to the petitioner. On such an execution petition being filed before the learned executing court concerned, thereupon the latter shall make a lawful speaking decision thereon, but after hearing all concerned.”

3.           However, despite the said directions being passed on July 24, 2023, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits, that yet no affirmative action has been drawn at the instance of Ld. Executing Court concerned.
4.           Consequently, the Ld. Executing Court concerned, is directed to forthwith issue, if not already issued, warrants of possession, and, if issued the said warrants of possession, be ensured to be completely executed, but within two weeks from today.
5.           Disposed of accordingly.
