1. Instant Writ Petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the remaining amount of service-cum-retirement dues of the petitioner, including the revised amount of gratuity, provident fund, leave encashment, revised pay scale, arrears of revised pay scale and all other benefits along with interest for delayed period in view of various instructions/letters/circulars of the State Government.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw present petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars by challenging speaking order dated 21.09.2022, if required.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
