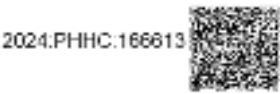
1. On December 04, 2024, the following order was passed:-

“The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that adverse police verification report has been submitted by the Punjab Police with the following comments:-

"Landlord not agree with applicant."

The learned counsel representing the petitioner further submits that the consent of landlord is not required if a tenant wants to apply for passport. However, adverse report has been given by the Ludhiana Police without referring to the provisions of the Passport Act, 1967.

2. Status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Akarshi Jain, Assistant Commissioner of Police (Civil Lines), Ludhiana has been filed with a copy to learned counsel representing the petitioner.
3. Learned State counsel admits that the police verification report is not properly worded. He prays for some time to forward proper report to the passport authorities. He submits that the earlier police verification report is withdrawn.
4. Keeping in view aforesaid development, the writ petition is rendered infructuous. However, the State House Officer, Police Station Division No.8, District Ludhiana is directed to forward the fresh police verification report in accordance with law within one week from today.
5. With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of.
