The petitioner was granted the concession of interim bail vide order dated 18.01.2024. Pursuant to the grant of interim bail, the said order was recalled on 14.05.2024 and the petitioner was directed to surrender forthwith. However, he didn’t do so and moved an application (CRM-31505-2024 in the connected matter bearing No.CRM-M-790-2024) for recalling of the said order. Vide order of the even date, the application for recalling stands dismissed.

As the petitioner is not in custody, the present petition for the grant of bail is, thus, not maintainable. Therefore, this petition stands dismissed.
