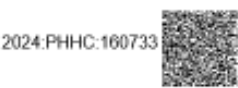

Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to official respondents No. 2 and 3 for providing protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and directing the private respondents No.4 to 6 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them in any manner, who are in a live-in-relationship.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that both the petitioners with their free will are staying in a live-in relationship and have also decided to get married after attaining the marriageable age as the date of birth of the petitioner No.1 is 02.11.2006 and petitioner No.2 is 22.11.2004. Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that petitioners have submitted a representation dated 29.11.2024 (Annexures P-3) to respondent



No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur mentioning the grievance raised herein, however the same has not been decided till date. It is further contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners would be satisfied if the representation dated 29.11.2024 (Annexure P-3) is decided by the respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur.

Notice of motion restricted to respondent Nos. 1 to 3, only.

Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, Assistant A.G. Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 and has no objection if the present petition is disposed of directing the respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to decide the representation dated 29.11.2024 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to decide the representation dated 29.11.2024 (Annexures P-3) of the petitioners after taking into consideration all the relevant aspects, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur for requisite compliance.
