SUMEET GOEL, J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for applicant-petitioners, at the outset, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw his vakalatnama.
2. Permission is granted and learned counsel for applicant-petitioners is discharged.
3. From the perusal of the application as also the main case it appears that there is no subsisting compromise between the parties as on today.
4. As regards the main case, report dated 26.04.2024 sent by the ld. JMIC, Amritsar shows that complainant has not got recorded the statement as per the order dated 23.01.2024.
5. Accordingly, the instant application deserves to be dismissed for non-prosecution.

6. Main case listed for 29.05.2024 pertains to quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise. As said hereinabove, it appears that there is no subsisting compromise between the parties and accordingly the main case is also dismissed for non-prosecution.
