SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner, who is in custody since 30.08.2023 for offences punishable under the NDPS Act, arising out of an incident of recovery of 1600 tablets of Clovedol, containing 542.400 grams of Tramadol, which is more than the commercial quantity, has filed this petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 272 dated 30.08.2023 under Sections 22 (c) of the NDPS Act (Section 29 of the NDPS Act added lateron) registered at Police Station STF Phase-IV Mohali, Bathinda.
2. It is informed that all the seizure witnesses are yet to be examined.
3. Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed for the time being with liberty to the petitioner to re-visit the Court for grant of bail, after examination of all the seizure witnesses.
