JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to grant benefits as per upgraded Annual Performance Assessment (APAR).

2. Mr. Karan Kumar Jund, Senior Panel Counsel for the respondents, at the outset, submits that petitioner has already been granted benefit of MACP and revised pay scale in view of upgraded APAR, thus, present petition is not maintainable.

3. Faced with this, Mr. P.K.S. Phoolka, Advocate submits that respondents may be directed to consider his pending claims.

4. As per petitioner, his claims on account of revised APAR are still pending whereas as per respondents, all the dues have already been released. This Court cannot adjudicate this disputed question of fact, however, requests the respondents to look into claim of the petitioner and if any due is outstanding, it may be released.

5. In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of.
