Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled for counting the service which he has rendered in the aided institution keeping in view the judgment in **CWP-4629 of 2012** titled as **Sunil Kumar Sharma and others Vs. State of Punjab and others**, which judgment has already been held by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India. Hence, the petitioner is entitled for the benefit as admissible to him under the judgment of **Sunil Kumar Sharma (supra)**.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised in the legal notice dated 28.10.2024 copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-8 and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case, a time bound direction be given to the respondents to decide the same by passing appropriate speaking order.

Mr. Swapan Shorey, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents-State submits that if legal notice dated 28.10.2024 (Annexure P-8) has been received by the concerned authority and is still pending consideration, appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order and in case the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner which reasons will be conveyed to the petitioner as well.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
