1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in their married life at the instance of respondents No.4 to 6 and their other relatives and friends.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of respondents no.4 to 6 and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents no.4 to 6. Their marriage certificate as well as marriage photographs evidencing their marriage are on record as Annexures P- 3 and P-4 The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 30.11.2024 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from ASI Sukhjit Singh has submitted that the petitioners have made statement before the Police on 03.12.2024 that they do not require any protection/security and they are not

apprehending any danger to their life and liberty. He has placed on record the statement dated 03.12.2024.

6. In view of the statement made by the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to pursue their remedy in case any further cause of action accrues to them, as per law.
