Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner No.1 is legally wedded wife of respondent No.5 and petitioners No.2 and 3 are their children; that, however, after leaving the company of petitioner No.1, respondent No.5 has started living with respondent No.6; that earlier petitioner No.1 gave power of attorney with regard to her property in favour of respondent No.5 and he misused the same and sold the plot owned by petitioner No.1 to someone else and in this regard, the petitioners lodged complaint (Annexure P-2) against respondent No.5. Now, respondents No.5 and 6 are pressurising the petitioners to withdraw the said complaint and respondent No.5 also trespassed into the house of the petitioners on 2.10.2023 and threatened them with dire consequences and in this regard, separate complaint (Annexure P-7) was given to the police authorities but they failed to take any action against respondents No.5 and 6.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if necessary direction is given to the police authorities to take necessary action against respondents No.5 and 6 in light of complaint (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Gurdarshan Singh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from ASI Mukhtiar Singh submits that the

police has taken preventive action against respondent No.5 and petitioner No.2 under Section 151 Cr.P.C. and they have already furnished security bonds. State counsel further submits that in case even now the petitioners are apprehending any threat at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6, the police authorities will take appropriate action in accordance with law.

4. Counsel for the petitioner is agreed to the aforesaid proposal.
5. In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide representation dated 3.10.2023 (Annexure P-7) in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
