HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the charge of the post of Senior Warden, on which post the petitioner was officiating, has been withdrawn which is causing prejudice to the petitioner as the petitioner is of the view that she has been granted regular promotion on the said post keeping in view the Resolution passed by the Syndicate to fill the post by way of promotion instead of direct recruitment.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner before the Vice-Chancellor, Punjabi University, Patiala vide representation dated 19.10.2024 (Annexure P-17), which is still pending consideration with the said authority and the petitioner will be satisfied at

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this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent-University to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Sanjeev Roy, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No. 1 to 3 and Mr. Swapan Shorey, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab.

5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 submits that in case the representation dated 19.10.2024 (Annexure P-17) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for respondents No. 1 to 3, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
