1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.0361 dated 05.11.2023, registered under Sections 406 and 420 of IPC and Section 24 of Emigration Act, 1983, at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 11.01.2024 passed by this Court, an amount of Rs.1.50 lacs has already been deposited with the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dasuya on 31.01.2024 and the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajwinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 20.01.2024 and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 11.01.2024, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
