The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.143 dated 19.04.2023 registered under Sections 323 and 365 IPC and (Sections 367, 325, 506, 201, 34 IPC added later on) registered at P.S. Model Town, Panipat, Haryana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 04.01.2024 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 04.01.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 04.01.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
