1. Status report by way of affidavit of Dr. Riputapan Singh P.P.S, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-division Ajnala, Amritsar (Rural) has been filed. Relevant part thereof reads as under:-

“3. That the respondent No.3 has reported in his aforesaid report dated 08.01.2024 that an enquiry relating the verification of the facts alleged in the present writ petition has been got conducted through ASI Jasbir Singh, who had recorded the statements of the petitioners and the private respondents. It is further reported that during the course of the aforesaid enquiry, it has been found that the marriage of the petitioner No.1 was solemnized with Amritpal Singh son of Om Parkash, who was a drug addict and there her marriage could not succeed and they got separate from each other through a Panchayati divorce. Thereafter, the petitioner No.1 started living in love-in relationship with the petitioner No. 2. It has

been further reported that the petitioners have stated in their respective statements that they do not have any threat from the private respondents and living together without any fear.

4. That the true translation of the report dated 08.01.2024 submitted by the respondent No. 3 is attached with for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court as Annexure R-1/T.

5. That so far as the question of protection of life and liberty of the petitioner is concerned, the police authorities of the Amritsar (Rural) are committed and duty bound to protect their life liberty by providing every possible help to them whenever required by them. The answering respondents undertake that necessary action will be immediately taken to ensure safety of life and liberty of the petitioners after carrying out ground level assessment and if the need be, adequate security will be provided to them accordance with the rules and procedure.”

2. Counsel for the petitioners records his satisfaction and prays for disposal of the petition in terms thereof.

3. Disposed off, accordingly.
