The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent No.4 against threatening for causing physical harm.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 26.12.2023 (Annexure P-6), within a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Anil Kumar Lamdharia, Addl. P.P., U.T., Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

However, without advertng to the merits of the case as has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner as well, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh, to look into the representation dated 26.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

However, nothing expressed hereinabove shall have any bearing on the merits of the case.
