1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to official respondents to conclude proceedings initiated against respondent No. 8.

2. The petitioner claims that he filed a complaint against respondent No. 8 wherein it was pointed out that matriculation certificate submitted by her is invalid.

3. On the basis of complaint, the Deputy Commissioner, Fatehabad issued show cause notice dated 24.08.2023 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No. 8. The said show cause notice was based on inquiry dated 08.06.2023 conducted by Sub Divisional Officer (C), Fatehabad. The Deputy Commissioner is sitting over the matter and despite lapse of more than one year, no action has been taken against respondent No. 8.
