1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the remaining payment of retiral dues of petitioner i.e. LTC w.e.f. 2016-2019, arrear of 2nd ACP w.e.f. 01.11.2018 to 28.02.2019 and benefit of 7th Pay Commission along with its arrear w.e.f. 01.01.2016 to 31.10.2022 and to revise the retiral dues accordingly and to release the payment of the aforesaid benefits along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had served the representations dated 26.12.2022 and 15.08.2023 vide Annexures P-6 & P-7 respectively to the respondents but the same have not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the aforesaid representations (Annexures P-6 & P-7) are considered and decided by respondent No.2 by passing a speaking order in accordance with law in a time bound manner.



3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.
5. Ms. Mansi, Advocate for Mr. Padamkant Dwivedi, Advocate has caused appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 & 3 and submitted that she has no objection, in case, a direction is issued to respondent No.2 for considering and deciding the representations dated 26.12.2022 and 15.08.2023 served by the petitioner vide Annexures P-6 & P-7 respectively in accordance with law and within a fixed time framework.
6. In view of the aforesaid position, without calling for the reply from the respondents and without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2/competent authority to consider and decide the representations dated 26.12.2022 and 15.08.2023 served by the petitioner vide Annexures P-6 & P-7 respectively strictly in accordance with law by passing a well-reasoned speaking order within a period of three months from today.
