1. Instant petition has been filed for directing the respondents to consider and grant the petitioner, who belongs to SC (R&O) category, appointment on the post of Assistant Field Officer by considering her candidature against two unfilled posts of Scheduled Caste (M&B) (Women) category in terms of Punjab Government instructions dated 08.04.1989 (Annexure P-7) forthwith and grant the petitioner all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for consideration of her claim, petitioner has moved representation dated 25.05.2023 (Annexure P-11) before the respondents, however, no decision has been taken thereon till date. He further submits that petitioner may be given liberty to supplement the said representation by filing a fresh representation and at this stage, petitioner would be

satisfied, if the said representation is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajesh Sehgal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondent No.3 is directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in representation dated 25.05.2023 (Annexure P-11) and supplementary representation, if any moved by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of said representation.

7. The petition stands disposed of.
