HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus seeking direction upon the respondents to immediately remove the illegally positioned/constructed garbage dumping pit in front of the petitioner's residence, which has resulted in unsanitary conditions and the menace of stray cattle.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that the petitioner has submitted representation dated 21.06.2024 (Annexure P-6) before the respondents; however, the same has not been adverted to by the concerned authorities, till date. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case a time

bound direction is issued to the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation,

Gurugram to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 21.06.2024 (Annexure P-6).

3. On advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Randhir Singh, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, appears on behalf of the respondents-State and opposes issuance of notice of motion. He further submits that the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram/competent authority shall take decision either way, on the pending representation dated 21.06.2024 (Annexure P-6) within a period of four weeks from today.

4. Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram/competent authority to consider and decide representation dated 21.06.2024 (Annexure P-6) by way of passing a speaking order, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all the concerned parties, within a period of four weeks from today.

5. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
