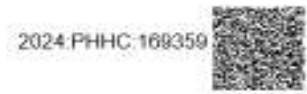

1. The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct respondent no.1 to issue passport.

2. The petitioner is an accused in FIR No.18, dated 15.02.2017, registered under Section 323, 324 IPC, at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga. The petitioner claims that the cancellation report has already been submitted by the prosecuting agency which is under consideration of the competent Court. In this case, the petitioner requested the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class to grant permission to go abroad, however, the same has been disposed of in terms of the judgment passed in **Anil Narula vs. State of Punjab (CRM-M-5848 of 2011)**.

3. Ms. Shreyansi Verma, the learned counsel representing the Union of India, submits that the petitioner has been requested to bring the requisite documents to enable the Regional Passport Officer to process his application. She has produced a copy of show cause notice issued to the



petitioner on 06.12.2024.

4. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner along with all the requisite documents will visit the office of Regional Passport Office, Jalandhar, during the course of next week commencing from 23.12.2024.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of while requesting the Regional Passport Officer, Jalandhar, to take a final call in accordance with law after the requisite documents are furnished by the petitioner, within a period of three weeks.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
