1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking setting aside of order dated 05.09.2022 Annexure P-2 passed by the Court of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sunam whereby the bail order of the petitioner was cancelled and he was directed to be summoned through non bailable warrants of arrest on account of his absence before the trial Court in a criminal case having FIR No.19 dated 30.01.2018, under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act and Section 483 of IPC, Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and apprised the Court that the petitioner has approached this Court after gap of more than two years of the passing of impugned order Annexure P-2 and in the given circumstances, the petitioner is not entitled to get any discretionary relief from this Court.

4. Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition be disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within next two weeks and to seek regular bail in accordance with law.

5. In light of the above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within next two weeks and to file an application seeking grant of regular bail which is to be disposed of by the said Court in accordance with law, preferably within a period of next two days of the filing of any such application.
