The petitioner has approached this Court raising a challenge to the inquiry report dated 28.06.2024 as well as to the final report dated 05.07.2024 that had been conducted/filed against the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that case FIR No.0035 dated 22.03.2024, had been registered against the petitioner under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Section 29 of the NDPS Act added later on) at Police Station City-1, District Sangrur.

An investigation into the same had been conducted and a final report dated 05.07.2024 had been filed.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the aforesaid FIR and that he had approached this Court for directing a fair investigation by constituting a Special Investigation Team (SIT) and vide order dated 10.05.2024 passed in CRM-M-19387-2024, an SIT headed by an officer not below the rank of Senior Superintendent of Police was ordered to be constituted by this Court. He contends that in compliance thereto, the inquiry report submitted by said SIT is also now a subject matter of challenge before this Court.

Final report has filed under Section 173 CrPC. (now Section 193 of the BNSS, 2023).

The investigation into the FIR has already been concluded and the SIT has also not accepted the contentions raised by the petitioner. It would not be appropriate for this Court to re-examine the investigation that had been conducted by the SIT, especially when the petitioner has other appropriate remedies to raise an objection to the report of the SIT before the Illaqa Magistrate or the competent forum.

Faced with above, counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take all the pleas before the competent forum.

Disposed of as not pressed with liberties as aforesaid.
