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SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner apprehending his arrest has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 109, dated 10.11.2024 under Sections 15, 29 and 61 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station City Dhuri, District Sangrur in respect of an incident which led to recovery of 30 kgs of poppy husk from the petitioner.
2. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has suffered previous conviction on 11.11.2023 and was awarded 10 years rigorous imprisonment alongwith a fine of Rs. 1 lac by the learned trial Court.
3. In view of the above, no case for granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.
4. The petition, accordingly, stands dismissed.
