The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for directing the Chandigarh Police to register FIR under Section 109, 118, 3(5) of BNS or under the relevant provisions against the accused persons, who attacked the petitioner in the broad day light on the basis of statement (Annexure P-3) given by the petitioner.

At the outset learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent to decide the representation.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the Senior Superintendent of Police Chandigarh is directed to look into the representation dated 01.12.2024 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from receipt of certified copy of this order.

A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

The petition is disposed of with the aforesaid terms.
