By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case
FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in
compliance to the order dated 11.12.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner
has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the
petitioner may be confirmed.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions received from ASI



Parveen has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required for further investigation.

4. Heard.

5. During the course of hearing on 11.12.2024, the following order was passed:-

“2. It is, inter alia, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case on account of some misunderstanding. He contends that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedents and now the misunderstanding inter se has been removed and a compromise has been effected between the parties on 30.11.2024, copy of which is Annexured as Annexure P-3. Hence, the instant petition seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

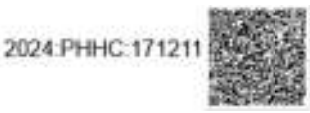
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent and prays for time to verify the facts of the matter.

5. Mr. Kuldeep Attri, Advocate, has entered appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed his vakalatnama to assist learned State counsel in the matter. The same is taken on record. He has also not disputed the factum of compromise having been effected between the parties on 30.11.2024 (Annexure P-3) and the specific affidavit furnished by Joginder Singh, complainant, in this regard. He submits that the copy of the affidavit shall be supplied to the Investigating Officer (concerned) within two days and the complainant will get his statement recorded with regard to the said fact as well.

6. Adjourned to 19.12.2024.

7. Needful be done well before the date fixed with an advance copy to the counsel opposite.

8. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within 05 days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under



Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS).

9. Investigating Officer (concerned) to remain present in Court along with relevant records on the date fixed.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 11.12.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 11.12.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
