1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that similar claim as being raised by the petitioner in the present writ petition has already been allowed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court while passing order in ***CWP No.19260 of 2014 titled as Harmandeep Kaur and others vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 13.11.2018 (Annexure P-2)*** but the benefit of the said judgment is not being extended to the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner was not party to the said writ petition hence, the respondents are liable to be directed to grant the petitioner the same benefit as extended to the petitioners in ***Harmandeep Kaur's case (supra)***.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, learned Sr. Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

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4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation/claim is received at the hands of the petitioner, the same will be decided by the competent authority by keeping in mind the judgment of the Coordinate Bench of this Court in ***Harmandeep Kaur's case (supra)***, within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such representation/claim by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file appropriate representation with the respondents.
