KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. The instant petition is a misconceived motion, inasmuch as, despite the petitioner being seized of an alternate and efficacious statutory remedy for redressal of his grievance, and without approaching the trial Court concerned, yet he has sidetracked the said remedy, and has straightway accessed this Court, through instituting the present petition.
2. In such circumstances, this Court refrains from exercising its power, as envisaged under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India. Accordingly, the instant petition is **disposed of**.
3. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioner to recourse the alternative available statutory remedy(ies), before the appropriate Court concerned, at the first instance, for the relief, as sought in the instant petition.
