1. Counsel for the petitioners inter alia submits that that both the petitioners who have attained aged of majority are living together against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7. It is further submitted that both the petitioners are unmarried and private respondents are extending threats to cause harm to them and they have moved representation Annexure P-3 dated 04.12.2024 to the police authorities but no action has been taken in this regard, till date by the authorities concerned.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.



4. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali to consider representation dated 04.12.2024 (Annexure P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 7 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
