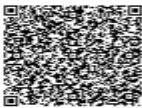

SUVIR SEHGAL J. (ORAL)

1. By way of instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has approached this Court *inter alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 13.11.2024, Annexure P-12, passed by respondent No.5, whereby application for renewal of arms license has been declined.
2. Advance copy of the petition has been served upon the respondents.
3. State Counsel has produced a copy of Memo No.3/928/2013-3HG-III dated 20.12.2013 to submit that the impugned order is appealable. The extract of the memorandum is reproduced hereunder:-



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“Reference to the D.O. letter No. Peshi/2013/744 Commissioner, Gurgaon Division Gurgaon, dated 19.11.2013 on the subject noted above.

2. It is informed/clarified The Commissioner of Police exercises the powers of District Magistrate and the appeal against the orders of Commissioners of Police shall lie to the Concerned Commissioner of Division. The Act itself is clear and this appeal against the orders of 5 (1) (b) and 5 (1) (c) shall lie to the Concerned Commissioner of Division. ”

4. In view of the above, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to avail the alternative remedy.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
