This petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents for stepping up of the petitioner's pay at par with the fourth respondent, who is junior to him.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the third respondent is directed to decide the pending legal notice, dated 11.09.2024, Annexure P-5, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. R. S. Budhwar, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 11.09.2024, will be decided by the third respondent/Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of six months.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
