The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant full benefits of service to the petitioner and the consequential benefits also after his acquittal in criminal case vide judgment dated 23.07.2021.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before respondent no.2. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide his legal notice, dated 25.01.2024, Annexure P-7, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rohit Arya, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents/State, and submits that the legal notice, dated 25.01.2024, will

be decided by respondent no.2 expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2-Director, Secondary Education, to consider and decide the legal notice, dated 25.01.2024, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within three weeks of receiving a certified copy of this order.

6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
