Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the secured asset was sold by the petitioner in an open auction and the sale certificate had been issued after the auction purchasers had paid the entire amount of Rs.10,61,37,000. The borrower had preferred SA before the DRT-I, Chandigarh and interim order was declined. Thereafter, the borrower had preferred an appeal before the DRAT and the DRAT has passed an interim order on 12.06.2024 restraining the Bank from handing over possession of the secured asset to the auction purchasers till the next date of hearing. However, the matter could not be taken up thereafter and has now been adjourned to 05.02.2025. He submits that DRAT be directed to decide the appeal filed by the borrower expeditiously, as the Bank and the auction purchasers are suffering due to the interim order.

2. In view of the afore-noted facts and circumstances, we deem it appropriate to request the DRAT to consider and decide the appeal filed by the borrowers/private respondents expeditiously.
3. The petition stands disposed of.
