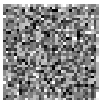
JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent No. 2 to consider his representation dated 07.06.2024 (Annexure P-4).

2. Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, Advocate submits that petitioner has filed representation dated 07.06.2024 with respondent No. 2 seeking extension of two years service. The petitioner is working as Home Guard volunteer and his date of superannuation was 31.07.2024. He is the sole bread winner of the family and needs two years' extension.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and waives service. He submits that respondent has passed order dated 12.12.2024 whereby claim of the petitioner has been rejected.
