Main case

1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents No.4 & 15 and not to harass or interfere in the married life of the petitioners at the instance of private respondents.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of the private respondents. He submits that this is the second marriage of both the petitioners, which is permissible under the customary law. They apprehend danger from the private respondents. Their marriage certificate evidencing their marriage is on record as Annexure P-3. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 02.12.2024 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2.
3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.
4. Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of



the State.

5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent no.2- Superintendent of Police, Palwal, to decide the representation (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived.

6. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. This order would not be understood having expressed any opinion whatsoever by this Court on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.
