1. Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS), prayer is made for grant of 'anticipatory bail' to the petitioner in case FIR no.36, dated 03.03.2020 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the IPC and under Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professional (Regulation) Act, registered at Police Station Nakodar Sadar, District Jalandhar.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner, while considering the fact the petitioner was already declared as a proclaimed person in the instant FIR, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the instant petition, with liberty to avail his alternate remedy, by challenging the order declaring him as a proclaimed person.
