MANISHA BATRA, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in case arising out of FIR No.73 dated 07.06.2023, registered under Sections 379-B IPC and Section 411 IPC (added later on), at Police Station Civil Lines Patiala, District Patiala. He was previously released on bail vide order dated 16.08.2023. He absented himself on 04.10.2023 due to which his bail was cancelled. Proceedings under Section 82 of Cr.P.C. were initiated against him and he was declared a proclaimed person on 07.06.2024. He was again arrested on 01.07.2024 and is in custody since then.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that his absence was not intentional but due to some miscommunication made with the lawyer engaged by him. Now he is in custody for a period of over five months. He is ready to abide by terms and conditions to be imposed upon him. He will not misuse the concession of bail. Therefore, it is urged that he may be extended benefit of bail.



3. The petitioner is in custody since 01.07.2024. The trial is likely to take time as 05 out of 10 prosecution witnesses are yet to be examined. The petitioner is ready to abide by the terms and condition to be imposed upon him. Taking into consideration the above said facts, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds by **two sureties** to the satisfaction of learned trial Court, further subject to the condition that he shall appear before the Station House Officer, Police Station, Civil Lines, Patiala on the 1st Monday of every month during the pendency of the trial for marking his presence, and further subject to the conditions that he will disclose his present as well as permanent address before the learned trial Court at the time of furnishing of bonds and shall also give copy of his Aadhar Card, PAN Card if any and details of his mobile phone number to the learned trial Court and in case, any change in his address or mobile phone number takes place, then he shall inform about the same to the learned trial Court in advance.

4. In case of violation of any of the above conditions, the jurisdictional Court shall be empowered to consider the application for cancellation, if any, and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.
