Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3, 12 (5) & (11) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2022 for issuing writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to grant parole to the petitioner to enable him to perform the necessary tasks as required and to enable him to meet with his family members as well as restore social ties and by considering reminder letter dated 17.09.2024 (Annexure P-1) and application vide which parole case of petitioner was initiated vide dispatch No.460-63 dated 08.01.2024 and decide the same at the earliest by considering the facts and law regarding the parole.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has already filed an application dated 08.01.2024, which has been forwarded to respondents No.2 and 3. He has further submitted that application for granting parole to the petitioner is pending for the last about one year, however, the same has not been decided till date.

Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the

State and has stated that the application of the petitioner will be decided expeditiously.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take decision on the application filed by the petitioner for granting him parole within a period of 15 days from today in accordance with law.
