1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not been given the posting at a nearby station after getting promoted despite the fact that the posts are available, hence, it becomes difficult for the petitioners to join at a far off place because of their ill health and they will have no other option but to deny the promotion, which will also debar the petitioners from getting the ACP benefits.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have filed the representation (Annexure P-6) with the respondents giving the details of the nearby Station where they can be accommodated on promotion



and the respondents be directed to decide the same by passing appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, Asstt. Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation (Annexure P-6) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible, the request of the petitioners will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be given while passing the order on the representation for not accepting the request of the petitioners and the same will be conveyed to the petitioners.
- 5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
- 6. Ordered accordingly.
