Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are not given benefit of pay scale for which they are entitled even while working on contractual basis only on the ground that they are being appointed through the Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the pay of the petitioners could not have been reduced by the change of the outsourcing agency hence, the petitioners are entitled for the grant of salary to the tune of Rs.27,150/- which should have been paid to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 09.05.2024 (Annexure P/9) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.
