1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents to extend the benefit of step up of pay at par with their juniors by removing anomaly in terms of order dated 22.08.2019 (Annexure P-1).
2. Mr. B. S. Sidhu, Advocate, at the outset, submits that grievance of the petitioners, at this stage, would be redressed if respondents are directed to decide their legal notice dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the competent Authority would look into grievance of the petitioners and legal notice would be appropriately answered within three months from today.
